## USE OF ALCOHOL ON SCHOOL PROPERTIES

### Rationale

As part of its service to the parish community schools often permit parish groups to hold social functions in their facility.

Alcohol is often served at such functions.

In addition the council and/or staff may wish to hold a function such as a wine and cheese party on specific occasions.

This policy will allow local councils to establish procedures which ensure that any group approved to use alcohol on school property fulfils the requirements of the B.C. Liquor Board and conducts its activities in a manner not to bring discredit to the school or cause damage to school property.

### Policy

Alcohol may be used by adults at certain social functions subject to conditions by the local school council.
